Guests can indulge in Asian cuisine at two restaurants on the property, both run by Executive Sous Chef and Michelin star winner, Richard Chen, as well as Chef Tony Ly and General Manager Bin An. **Song** features Cantonese, Shanghai, and Szechuan flavors with delectable eats including Wok Tossed Dungeness Crab, Shanghainese Pork Soup Dumpling, Glutinous Rice Dumpling, and more, provided with western hospitality and eastern gracious service. For those seeking other high-energy Asian options, **YouYu** is the hotel and casino’s noodle bar, with a live-action cooking station, inspired by tasty street food. YouYu focuses on freshly made Dim Sum, Asian BBQ noodle dishes, and savory broths.
